- Training devices allowed only in classes No. 12 & 47
- ASTM/SEI approved helmets <u>MUST</u> be worn in all classes over fences and when practicing over jumps. Show management strongly recommends helmets for all other classes.
- ASTM/SEI approved helmets **MUST** be worn by all participants under the age of 18.
- English tack and attire must be worn in English classes according to style
- Western tack and attire must be worn in Western classes according to style
- Novice horse a horse that has not won three first place ribbons, 4-H included
- Maiden horse a horse that has never won a first place, 4-H included
- Junior horse five years or younger
- Green horse –first year of horse showing western or English
- Lead line class 13 rider may not enter any other mounted classes; may enter in 1,2,3,4.
- Walk / Trot classes 10, 11, 43, 48 horse and rider combination cannot cross enter in to canter classes. Classes may be combined at discretion of show officials. Combo may enter class 1,2,3,4 & 29,30,31
- Class 35 Ground Pole- green horse and rider combo in first 2 years of jumping and have not shown over 18"
- Class 36 Cross Rail Jumper green horse and rider combination in their first 2 years of jumping and have not shown over 2'
- Class 38 Grass Hopper Jumper- green horse or rider in first 3 years of jumping, horse and rider combo have not shown over 2' 3"
- Class 39 Limited Hunter-horse and rider combo that have not shown higher than 2' 6"
- Classes will be judged according to current USA Equestrian rule book unless otherwise stated
- Judges decision is final
- Trail classes will be judged by a separate judge from approximately 12:00pm to 3:00pm. After an accumulation of 6 refusals horse/rider will be eliminated from the class
- Class 1 and Class 3 show simultaneously and Class 2 and Class 4 show simultaneously
- Class 24 and Class 57 are non colored classes. Non colored horses include, Grey, Bay, Black, Brown, Sorrel/Chestnut
- Class 8 bareback class--dollar bill class. Bring your own dollar. Payout 50%, 30%, 20%.
- Class 9 bareback class—boot rings. Start with one ring on each boot. Last one with one ring left wins.
- Class 28 thread reins. Thread for reins; leave your reins around saddle horn for safety.

RELEASE
